SPANISH EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

GENERAL EDUCATION

- 1. Infant Education: Between 0 and 6 years.
- 2. Junior Education: From 6 to 12 years.
- 3. Compulsory Secondary Education: Between 12 and 16 years.
- 4. Baccalaureate: Between 16 and 18 years.
- 5. Specific Vocational Training:
 - a. *Middle Level Training Cycles*: From 16 years
 - b. *Higher Level Training Cycles*: From 18 years
- 6. University Education: From 18 years

INFANT EDUCATION

1. For children aged between 0 and 6.

Two cycles, each lasting three school years:

-the first cycle: is for children between 0-3.

-the second cycle: children up to 6.

It is voluntary

Its objective is to contribute to children's physical, intellectual, affective, social and moral development.



JUNIOR EDUCATION

- This is free of charge.
- It is designed for children aged between 6 and 12.
- The aim is to provide school children with the following skills:
 - reading and writing.
 - basic mathematic procedures.
 - an initiation into a foreign language.
 - basic cultural elements.
 - physical education as a means to corporal development.



- • It is taught: *In state schools* Grouped Rural Schools (CRA)
Compulsory Education Schools (CEO)

COMPULSORY SECONDARY EDUCATION (ESO)

- This free of charge.
- It is normally for children aged between 12 and 16.
- It is made up of 4 school years.
- It includes assessment, with grades from 0 to 10.
- Those pupils who do not obtain the Certificate of Secondary Education may access the Social Guarantee Programmes.

BACCALAUREATE

- Two school years.
- Pupils begin at the age of 16 and finish at 18.
 - Entrance requirement: Certificate of Secondary Education.
- Pupils may choose from four areas:
- 1. Technology.
- 2. Natural and Health Sciences.
- 3. Humanities and Social Sciences.
- 4. Arts.

SPECIFIC VOCATIONAL TRAINING. TRAINING CYCLES

- Divided into Middle Level and Higher Level and Training Cycles.
- The Training Cycles are organized into Professional Groups.
- Middle Level Training Cycles may be accessed on completion of Compulsory Secondary Education.
- Higher Level Training Cycles may be accessed on completion of the Baccalaureate.

SOCIAL GUARANTEE PROGRAMMES

- Designed for pupils who fail to reach the objectives of Compulsory Secondary Education.
- Specific programmes to provide pupils with basic professional skills, (that will enable them to enter the labour market or to continue their studies).
- They are taught in education centres or alternatively by town and city councils and other authorised institutions.
 - Free of charge.

DIVERSITY

- Series of actions included within the Education System aimed at addressing.
- Focus on the specific needs of certain pupils in the light of their diversity and characteristics.
- Pupils with special educational needs: disabilities or serious personality or behaviour disorders. Such pupils attend Special Education Schools.
- Replacement Classes or Standard Schools. This type of education option includes support teachers.

ADULT EDUCATION

- - Available for anyone over 18 without basic education qualifications, as well as young people, workers and the unemployed.
 - It is taught free of charge in specific State Schools and Centres.
